
The draft curriculum and regulations for Allied Health Science courses which was circulated to all the BOS members was taken up for discussion. The proposed courses were

- a. B.Sc. Medical Laboratory Technology
- b. B.Sc. Anesthesia and Operation Theatre Technology
- c. B.Sc. Emergency and Trauma Care Technology
- d. B.Sc. Renal Dialysis Technology
- e. B.Sc. Medical Imaging and Radiology Technology
- f. Masters in Public Health

On discussion, few changes were suggested to be incorporated into the draft. Regarding the syllabus, it was decided to approve the programmes for the First Year B.Sc. courses which are common to all the courses. The respective speciality programmes commence from the Second Year onwards. Since the National Commission for Allied and Health Care Professions is constituted, it was decided that the guidelines could be awaited before the syllabus for the speciality programmes were to be decided.

The draft copy for curriculum and regulations and the syllabus for the Masters in Public Health were approved.

The meeting concluded with thanking the members for active participation.
