B.Sc. Nursing

The Nursing course at Dayananda Sagar University will equip the graduate nurse with the knowledge, skills and attitude to deliver patients high-quality, complex essential care.

The institution endeavors to educate nurses in an appropriate learning environment to be efficient and safe practitioners of international standards. The nursing students are trained to provide quality patient care based on our strong commitment towards education, practice, research, innovation and collaboration.

Duration: 4 Years (8 semesters)

Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing & B.Sc. Nursing**

B.Sc. Nursing Eligibility

Pass in 10+2, A Level, IB, American 12th grade or equivalent with Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English and a minimum of 45% marks in Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English. Eligibility shall be 40% for SC, ST and OBC candidates.

USPs For B.Sc. Nursing

College is attached with the Parent Hospital.

B.Sc. Nursing

B.Sc. Job Roles and Descriptions

Teacher of Nursing: Educates students pursuing nursing degrees, providing instruction in various nursing-related subjects. Develops lesson plans, conducts lectures, and facilitates discussions and hands-on learning activities.

Staff Nurse: Provides direct patient care in various healthcare settings, including hospitals, clinics, and long-term care facilities. Administers medications, performs treatments, and assists with procedures as prescribed by healthcare providers.

Nursing Service Administrators: Manages the administrative aspects of nursing services within a healthcare facility. Oversees staffing, scheduling, and budgeting for nursing departments.

Director of Nursing: Provides leadership and strategic direction to the nursing staff and departments within a healthcare organisation. Develops and implements policies and procedures to ensure high-quality patient care and compliance with regulations.

Military Nurse: Provides healthcare services to military personnel, their families, and veterans. Military healthcare facilities deliver primary, emergency, and preventive health services.

Assistant Nursing Superintendent: Assists the nursing superintendent in managing the nursing staff and operations within a healthcare facility. Provides leadership and support to nursing staff, including scheduling, training, and performance management.

Industrial Nurse: Provides healthcare services to employees within industrial settings such as factories, manufacturing plants, and construction sites. Addresses work-related injuries, illnesses, and health concerns.

Nursing Superintendent: Oversees the nursing staff and operations within a healthcare facility. Provides leadership, direction, and support to nursing personnel.

Community Health Nurse (CHN): Provides healthcare services to individuals, families, and communities in various community settings. Focuses on health promotion, disease prevention, and wellness education.

Public Health Educator: Educators develop and implement programs to promote public health and prevent disease. They may work in communities, schools, or healthcare organisations to educate people about healthy behaviours and disease prevention strategies.

Clinical Nurse Specialist (CNS): Clinical Nurse Specialists are advanced practice nurses specialising in a particular healthcare area, such as oncology, paediatrics, or mental health. They provide expert clinical care research and educate staff on best practices.

Post Basic B.Sc. in Nursing

Post Basic B.Sc. degree in Nursing is a broad based education aimed to build upon the skills and competencies acquired at the diploma in nursing level. It is specifically directed to the upgrading of critical thinking skills, competencies and standards required for practice of professional nursing and midwifery as envisaged in National Health Policy.

Duration: 2 Years (4 semesters)

Post Basic B.Sc. in Nursing Eligibility

Pass in GNM after 10+2 or equivalent examination preferably with Science subjects with 50% marks in aggregate. Candidates should be a registered Nurse and registered Midwife or equivalent with any State Nursing Council Registration. Candidates should have completed their GNM course on or before 01.06.2020. Not have crossed 48 years of age on commencement of the course.

Career Opportunities

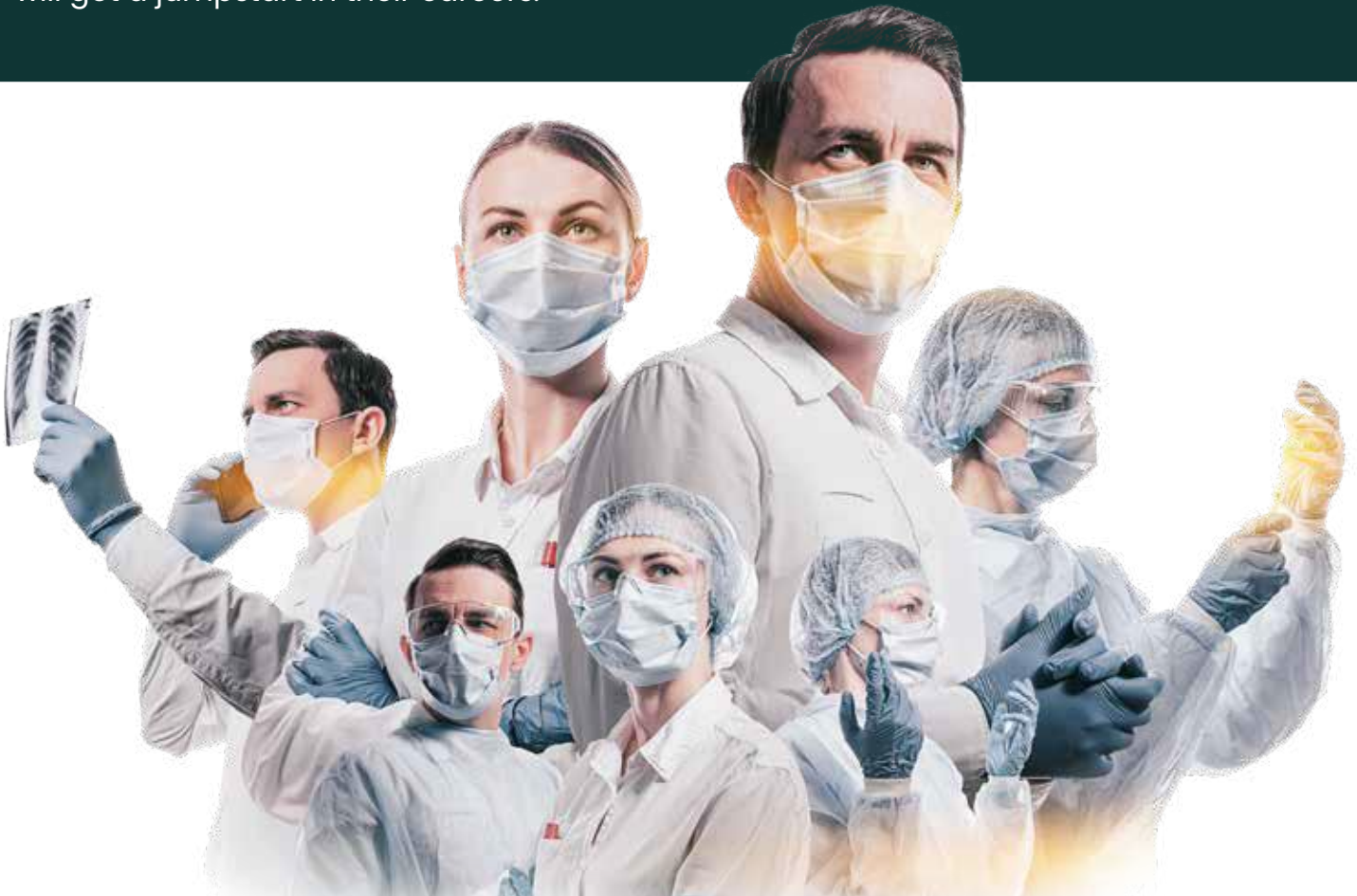
The PB B.Sc. in Nursing is a 2-year, full time UG program from DSU, enabling present professionals to acquire better skills and get better opportunities. Usually pursued after the completion of General Nursing & Midwifery (GNM), The course provides in-depth knowledge about various nursing techniques in treating patients, assisting doctors, and learning about preventive and rehabilitative methodologies.

A blend of classroom lectures and hands-on training through practical sessions, the course empowers students to make independent decisions in various nursing scenarios and includes subjects like Microbiology, Maternal Nursing, Medical & Surgical Nursing, and Mental Health Nursing.

The College of Nursing Sciences, DSU has world class infrastructure and facilities backed by experienced faculty. The curriculum provides a good understanding of the concepts and skills required to deliver in competitive environments.

We have an affiliation to various government hospitals such as Victoria, Vani Vilas, Kidwai Cancer Institute and Indira Gandhi Institute of Child Health and NIMHANS. We also have an MOU with our partner institutions in Malaysia.

Post Basic B.Sc. Job Roles and Descriptions

Registered Nurse (RN): Registered nurses provide and coordinate patient care, educate patients and the public about various health conditions, and provide advice and emotional support to patients and their families.

Clinical Research Associate (CRA): Clinical Research Associates manage and monitor clinical trials conducted by pharmaceutical and biotechnology companies. They ensure trials comply with protocols, regulatory requirements, and good clinical practices.

Laboratory Technician: Laboratory Technicians conduct tests and experiments in various scientific and medical laboratories. They may perform tasks such as analysing samples, preparing solutions, and maintaining laboratory equipment.

Medical Laboratory Scientist: Medical Laboratory Scientists perform complex laboratory tests on patient samples to help diagnose and treat diseases. They analyse blood, tissue, and other bodily fluids using sophisticated laboratory equipment.

Public Health Educator: Educators develop and implement programs to promote public health and prevent disease. They may work in communities, schools, or healthcare organisations to educate people about healthy behaviours and disease prevention strategies.

Healthcare Administrator: Healthcare Administrators manage the day-to-day operations of healthcare facilities such as hospitals, clinics, and nursing homes. They oversee staff, budgets, and resources to ensure efficient and effective delivery of healthcare services.

Clinical Nurse Specialist (CNS): Clinical Nurse Specialists are advanced practice nurses specialising in a particular healthcare area, such as oncology, paediatrics, or mental health. They provide expert clinical care research and educate staff on best practices.

Health Information Manager: Health Information Managers oversee patient health information collection, storage, and analysis. They ensure that medical records are accurate, confidential, and accessible to authorised personnel.

Community Health Worker: Community Health Workers provide outreach and support services to individuals and communities to promote health and wellness. They may conduct home visits, organise health fairs and connect people with resources and services.

Occupational Health and Safety Specialist: Occupational Health and Safety Specialists develop and implement programs to protect workers from job-related injuries and illnesses. They inspect workplaces, identify hazards, and recommend safety measures to employers.

Throughout the course, students will learn to practice person-centred nursing compassionately and respectfully, promoting dignity and well-being. Graduate nurses will develop the ability to act with professionalism and integrity and work within agreed professional, ethical and legal frameworks and processes to maintain and improve standards of health care.

M.Sc. Nursing Eligibility

Candidates should have passed **BSc/PC BSc/PB BSc Nursing** recognised by the Indian Nursing Council and a minimum of **55% marks in aggregate** .

50% marks in case of SC, ST and category-I, OBC candidates from Karnataka.

Experience: Applicants must have one year of experience after obtaining a B.Sc. in Nursing in a hospital, community health program, school, or nursing college. PB B.Sc Degree holders must have one year of experience before or after an essential B.Sc. Nursing degree. Candidates should be registered nurses and Midwives or equivalent with any State Nursing Council Registration.

M.Sc. Job Roles and Descriptions

Home Care Nurses: Junior Psychiatric Nurses work under the supervision of experienced psychiatric nurses and mental health professionals to provide care for patients with psychiatric disorders or mental health issues.

Junior Psychiatric Nurses: Home Care Nurses provide medical and personal care to patients who are unable to leave their homes due to illness, injury, or disability. They assess patients' conditions, administer medications, dress wounds, and provide basic medical care.

Nursing Executive: Nursing Executives, also known as Nurse Executives or Nurse Managers, oversee nursing departments and ensure the delivery of high-quality patient care. They are responsible for developing and implementing nursing policies and procedures, managing nursing staff, and maintaining regulatory compliance.

Staff Nurse: Staff Nurses provide direct patient care in various healthcare settings, including hospitals, clinics, nursing homes, and rehabilitation centers. They assess patients' health status, administer medications, perform medical procedures, and monitor vital signs.

Nurse Educator: Nurse Educators are responsible for developing, implementing, and evaluating educational programs for students and practising nurses. They design curriculum materials, teach classes, and facilitate clinical training experiences in classroom and healthcare settings.

Registered Nurse: Provides direct patient care, including assessment, planning, implementation, and evaluation of nursing care. Administers medications, performs treatments, and assists with procedures as ordered by healthcare providers.

Nursing In Charge: Assumes responsibility for managing and coordinating nursing care within a specific unit or department. Supervises nursing staff, assigns duties, and ensures that patient care activities are carried out effectively and efficiently.

Nursing Supervisor: Provides leadership and oversight to nursing staff within a healthcare facility. Coordinates staffing, scheduling, and workflow to ensure adequate coverage and efficient operation of nursing units.

Nursing Executive: A leadership position within a healthcare organisation that oversees nursing operations and strategy. Develops and implements policies, procedures, and programs to promote quality patient care and ensure regulatory compliance.

Nurse Educator: Designs, develops, and delivers educational programs and materials for nursing students, practising nurses, and other healthcare professionals. Teaches courses, conducts workshops, and facilitates learning experiences in classroom, clinical, and online settings.

Paramedic Nurse: Provides advanced nursing care in pre-hospital emergency settings, often as part of a paramedic team. Assesses patients' conditions, administers medications, and performs interventions to stabilise patients in critical situations.
