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Report of NSS Activity on TB Awareness Program at Jakkasandra Village

Date: April 23, 2025

Location: Jakkasandra Village Bengaluru

Organized by: NSS Unit, Department of CST, DSU

Objective:

To raise awareness about Tuberculosis (TB) – its causes, symptoms, prevention, and treatment – among the residents of Jakkasandra village, and to promote public health through knowledge dissemination and community interaction.

Program Summary:

The NSS unit of the Department of Computer Science and Technology, Dayananda Sagar University, organized a one-day TB Awareness Program at Jakkasandra village. The event was part of our community outreach initiative aimed at promoting health education and creating social responsibility among students.

Around **30 NSS student volunteers** actively participated in the program. The team prepared educational posters, pamphlets in Kannada, and interactive presentations to effectively communicate the message to the villagers. The awareness session included:

- **Introduction to Tuberculosis:** Causes and types of TB
- **Symptoms:** Persistent cough, fever, night sweats, weight loss
- **Mode of Transmission:** Airborne spread and risk factors
- **Prevention Methods:** BCG vaccination, hygiene practices, wearing masks
- **Treatment and Government Schemes:** Free diagnosis and treatment through DOTS, support from public health centers
- **Q&A Session:** Villagers were encouraged to ask questions and clarify doubts

The session was delivered in Kannada to ensure effective communication and understanding.

Impact and Outcome:

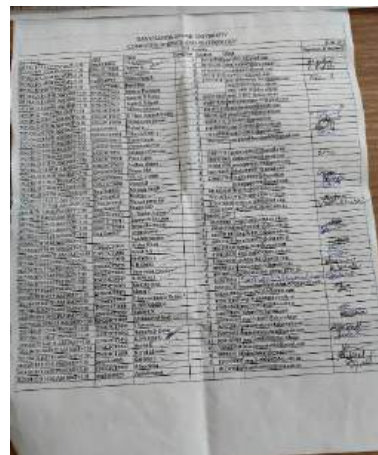
- Reached over **40 houses of the village**, including school children, adults, and senior citizens.
- Distributed over 50 **pamphlets** on TB awareness.
- Improved understanding of TB symptoms and government healthcare services among the local population.

- Encouraged early diagnosis and treatment by sharing contact information of nearby PHCs.

Conclusion:

The TB Awareness Program was a successful NSS initiative by the CST department students of DSU. It not only helped in educating the villagers but also instilled a sense of responsibility among the students to contribute towards public health and well-being. The event received positive feedback from the villagers and local authorities.
