Event Details:

On the eve of Charles Babbage Birth Anniversary, on December 26th, 2022, the Department of Computer Science and Engineering (cyber security) organised an event "TechNite-Computer and Networking Hardware Exhibition" for first-year students and a "Quiz competition" for first-year Computer Science and Engineering (cyber security) students.

Dr Udaya Kumar Reddy KR, Dean, SoE, inaugurated the event. Students from the Computer Science and Engineering (cyber security) department, explained the history and demonstrated the working principle of the various Computer and Networking hardware components. There were 10 counters explaining different hardware components namely, Parts of a Computer, SMPS, Input Devices, Output Devices, Mother Board, Processor, Memory, Networking, Laptop assembling and disassembling and Cyber Security tools. Totally 266 students and 39 faculty visited the exhibition. It was a great interaction with the dean, faculty and student visitors. Both the volunteer team as well as visiting students enjoyed the learning. Students and faculty handling first year courses expressed their opinion that it made their teaching and learning easy in the classroom with the kind of components being exhibited. This exhibition was helpful for first year students in realizing the hardware components that are being taught to them in theory classes.

Along with the "TechNite" event a Quiz competition for First year CSE(CY) students was also organized. There were 30 participants. Winners of the Quiz were appreciated with Certificates, during the "TechNite" event.
