Tuberculosis (TB) is a contagious bacterial infection caused by *Mycobacterium tuberculosis*. It primarily affects the lungs but can also affect other parts of the body such as the brain, kidneys, or spine.

India has set ambitious goals and a comprehensive vision to eliminate tuberculosis (TB) as a public health problem. The Indian government's vision for TB eradication is outlined in its National Strategic Plan for Tuberculosis Elimination (NSP) and aligns with global targets set by organizations such as the World Health Organization (WHO).
