

Abstract submission guidelines for CDD-2023

- The abstract should be **no more than 250 words** long (Be concise and to the point)
- **Title:** The title should be concise and informative, and should accurately reflect the content of the abstract.
- **Authors and Affiliations**
- **Introduction:** The introduction should provide a brief overview of the research topic and the relevant literature.
- **Methods:** The methods section should describe the study design, the participants, the interventions, and the data collection and analysis methods.
- **Results:** The results section should present the key findings of the study in a clear and concise manner.
- **Conclusions:** The conclusions should summarize the main findings of the study and discuss their implications.
- **Keywords:** A list of keywords (5-7) should be included to facilitate indexing and retrieval of the abstract.

Here are some additional tips for writing a strong structured abstract:

- Use clear and concise language. Avoid jargon and technical terms that may not be understood by the general audience.
- Use keywords that are relevant to your research topic. This will help people find your abstract when someone is searching for information on your topic.
- Proofread your abstract carefully before submitting it. Make sure there are no errors in grammar or spelling.
